HOME GROUP QUESTIONS

Week 2 | 1.19.25Scripture:The Book of ExodusExodus 15:1-18

Group Gathering Question:

How would you celebrate a long-awaited victory (a milestone birthday, a wedding, a baby being born, a sports championship or a family member winning an award)?

Read this week's Scripture and discuss these questions.

- 1. What is the cause of this song from Moses and the Israelites? What do you imagine the scene being like as they sang?
- 2. This song never mentions Moses, Aaron or Miriam instead it is God-centered worship. Notice in verse 2 it says, "The Lord is my strength," not "the Lord gives me strength." What is the difference between the two?
- 3. How do God's actions in verses 3-8 align with his steadfast love in verse 13? Put yourself in the place of an Egyptian. How would you feel toward God? How is that different from how you would feel as an Israelite? What do you make of that discrepancy?
- 4. How would you define *hesed* (steadfast love)? How have you been shaped by experiencing steadfast love or by not having experienced steadfast love?
- 5. What miracle has God done or what prayer has God answered that you could sing about? Do you have a hymn or song in mind you would use if you were celebrating a victory with God?
- 6. What role does creativity (music, art, drama, writing, etc.) play in your relationship to God? What part does creativity play in the church? Would you be willing to write a few lines of a poem or a verse to a song that praises God or gives God thanks?
- 7. Have you ever considered the power (or even danger) of worship or does that feel like a foreign or strange concept to you?
