HOME GROUP QUESTIONS

Week 4 | 2.2.25 The Book of Exodus Scripture: Exodus 17:8-16

Group Gathering Question:

Have a few people in your group, or everyone, hold out a heavy book (or similar heavy item) at arm's length in front of them. See how heavy it gets and who can keep it there the longest without dropping their hand!

Read this week's Scripture and discuss these questions.

- 1. In the story as a whole, what are the different ways in which Moses, Joshua, Aaron, and Hur exhibit leadership?
- 2. What do you think Moses was trying to accomplish by standing on top of the hill with the staff of God in his hands? Where do you think this idea came from?
- 3. Who or what has held up your arms in a time of crisis or stress? How are you at being Aaron and Hur and giving support to someone else?
- 4. In addition to Moses' arms being held up, God is also at work to help the Israelites win the battle. What battle has God helped you win? What battle would you like the Lord to fight for you/fight with you right now?
- 5. Moses had an altar built and called it, "The Lord is my Banner." Finish this phrase for your own life: "The Lord is my ."
- 6. We are told that the Lord would have war with Amalek from generation to generation. Craig Barnes suggests that we will always have enemies (like the Amalekites) and that these enemies are used by God to mold our souls. How has God used an enemy you have battled in order to shape you more like Jesus?
