Week 5 | 2.9.25Scripture:The Book of ExodusExodus 18:1-27

Group Gathering Question:

Growing up, how were disputes or arguments handled in your family? How are disputes handled in your family now?

Read this week's scripture and discuss these questions.

- 1. Moses named his sons after particular seasons of his life. If you had a child born in this season of your life what would you call the child? Autumn, Winter, Summer, Spring, or something else?
- 2. What kind of relationship did Moses have with his father-in-law? What is it like to have good relationships with parents/in-laws and what is it like to have difficult relationships with parents/in-laws?
- 3. What are some words you would use to describe Jethro's approach with Moses? See Exodus 18:24 for how Moses responded. How do you think Moses was able to respond this way to his father-in-law?
- 4. When was there a time when you felt overwhelmed as Moses must have felt? In your own life, have you been able to listen to other's advice which might include giving up control, letting go and delegating?
- 5. What were the important points of Jethro's plan that would make it a success? What are the benefits of splitting up responsibilities in a church (or in your home or at work) to smaller groups, sharing leadership, and delegating important work?
- 6. What is one area of your life that you would like to explore or sink more deeply into? To do so, what area of your life might you need to stop exploring or engaging in, in order to allow this to happen?
