HOME GROUP QUESTIONS

Week 6 | 2.16.25 The Book of Exodus Scripture: Exodus 19

Group Gathering Question:

Have you ever had a "mountain top" experience in your faith? Where did that take place?

Read this week's scripture and discuss these questions.

- Read 1 Peter 2:9. This passage, about the church, is clearly echoing Exodus 19. What does it mean that the church is called a "royal priesthood and a holy nation?" What does this mean about you?
- Verse 4 compares God with the image of an eagle. What image from scripture or elsewhere is a helpful one for you in understanding God?
- 3. Why does God want the people to wash their clothes and be consecrated? Why does God use thunder and lightning, trumpet blasts, smoke, and a trembling mountain?
- 4. Would you even want to meet God face-to-face like Moses did? If not, who would you trust to go in your place? Would you feel jealous or intimidated or impressed by a person who meets with God?
- 5. After all is said and done, who met with (or heard from) God that day? Was it just Moses, or Moses and Aaron, or Moses and Aaron and the priests and the people? What messages did these people receive from God?
- 6. Have you ever truly experienced the presence of God? Was it quiet or dramatic? What impact did that have on you?
