Week 7 | 2.23.25  
The Book of Exodus

Scripture:  
Exodus 16

### Group Gathering Question:

What is the strangest thing you have ever eaten? What food could you eat every day of your life?

### Read this week's scripture and discuss these questions.

1. When have you felt like you were walking through a wilderness? What things did you think you needed to survive? What things did you depend on to get you through that season?
2. Why do you think the people, having seen God's awesome power, could complain so soon? It seems their complaining, or grumbling, gets Moses' and God's attention. What would you do to try and get God's attention?
3. What lesson was God teaching the Israelites through the manna and the quail?
4. Why is the Sabbath so important to God and to the people in this story? Do you practice Sabbath on Sunday or some other day, or in some other way, during the week?
5. In what areas do you find it hard to trust God right now? How can the members of your group pray for you and walk with you?
6. Have you ever repeated a daily prayer or liturgy? How did it change your perspective of God, yourself, and others? How could you begin to build more rhythms of returning to God's table into your day?
