

# **HOME GROUP QUESTIONS**

### Week 8 | 3.2.25 The Book of Exodus

Scripture: Exodus 20:1-21

## **Group Gathering Question:**

Who "laid down the law" in your household? Did you ever try to bend the rules?

## Read this week's Scripture and discuss these questions.

- 1. What passed for an idol back then (see Deuteronomy 4:15-19)? Today, what passes for idols or other gods that might take the place of our God?
- 2. What does it mean that God is a jealous God (verse 5)? What does verse 6 say about the kind of relationship that God desires from his people?
- 3. What did the rules you grew up with tell you about your parents (or what do the rules you have for your family now say about you as a parent)? What do these 10 commandments tell us about who God is?
- 4. How might following the 10 commandments be an invitation to others to experience the love and freedom of God?
- 5. Why do you think coveting is one of the 10 commandments? Does it really hurt anyone if I internally desire something that is not available to me?
- 6. Near the end of the passage, the people are afraid of God and don't want God to speak to them directly. What does Moses share about why God has come in verse 20? How might we reconcile that Moses says "Do not fear" then talks about the fear of God in this same verse?
