

HOME GROUP QUESTIONS

Week 9 | 3.9.25 The Book of Exodus

Scripture: Exodus 23:1-17

Group Gathering Question:

God discusses taking time off for the Sabbath and for festivals here in Exodus 23. Share a story about a favorite "festival" or what you like to do to rest or relax (like a Sabbath).

Read this week's scripture and discuss these questions.

- Exodus 23:1-4 uses examples that don't sound like the way we say things today. In your group, relate "false report, malicious witness," or the teachings on the ox or the donkey to situations we might face today.
- 2. Look up definitions of justice and mercy. In Exodus 23:1-9, where are justice and mercy seen here? How are justice and mercy related to one another?
- 3. "You shall not oppress a resident alien; you know the heart of an alien, for you were aliens in the land of Egypt." What does the heart of an alien look like?
- 4. Exodus 23 is at least the third time God has brought up the Sabbath in Exodus. Why do you think the Sabbath is so important to God? Specifically in verses 10-13, why is the Sabbath important here and how might we practice this today?
- 5. What is a physical practice that you can engage in that shapes your spiritual life in a way that cultivates your having more compassion for others?
- 6. In regards to festivals at the end of Exodus 23, what's your favorite holy day and favorite holiday during the year? Consider Easter, Christmas, Thanksgiving, July 4th or other holidays; and also Ash Wednesday, Good Friday, or Sunday Sabbath.
