

# HOME GROUP QUESTIONS

#### Week 10 | 3.16.25 The Book of Exodus

Scripture: Exodus 24

#### Group Gathering Question:

How do you rate yourself as keeping promises? How did you do at keeping promises when you were a kid or a teen?

#### Read this week's scripture and discuss these questions.

- 1. Imagine yourself in this story. What stands out to you? What surprises you or disturbs you? What do you find intriguing?
- 2. Moses serves as a mediator between God and the people of Israel. Do you feel as if you serve as a mediator between God and anyone? If so, why do you think this is helpful or not helpful?
- 3. The people said that they would do everything that God told them to do. But they simply can't keep the commands. Why is it so difficult for us to keep God's commands?
- 4. Is God's covenant sustained, then and now, with his grace or the people's obedience? Why do you think so?
- 5. Some of the people, including 70 elders, went up and "saw God and ate and drank." Does this seem very strange to you? Would you like to be part of the group to go up to see God?
- 6. 1 John 4:12 says that if we love one another that God dwells in us. Has there been a time when the way in which a church community has loved has allowed you to see God?
