

HOME GROUP QUESTIONS

Week1 | 4.6.25 The Book of Exodus

Scripture: Exodus 33.12-23

Group Gathering Question:

When you get to Heaven and see God face-to-face, is there a certain question you want to ask God? If yes, what is it?

Read this week's Scripture and discuss these questions.

- 1. Exodus 33 is preceded by the story of the golden calf in Exodus 32. Read Exodus 32:30-35. How does Moses see the situation? How does God see the situation? Is this fair?
- 2. God tells Moses to lead the people and go to the Promised Land. But God is so angry he will not go with them. Instead, he will send an angel. How serious is this situation for the Israelites and what is the danger? If you sensed God told you that you could go somewhere but God wouldn't go with you, what would you do?
- 3. Have you ever felt comfortable enough with God to speak to him as a friend (see Exodus 33:11 and John 15:15)? If not, what holds you back? Is it different to think of Jesus as a friend than God the Father or the Holy Spirit as a friend?
- 4. What does God's presence mean to Moses? What will it mean to the people as they travel? Can you put in your own words what God's presence means to you?
- 5. The exchange between God and Moses in verses 17-23 is unique and profound. What strikes you about what Moses says? What strikes you about what God says?
- 6. God allows Moses to see his back but holds his hand over him to keep him from seeing God's face. Without physically seeing God, was there a time when you saw God or when you absolutely sensed God's presence?
