HOME GROUP QUESTIONS

Week 3 | 4.20.25
The Book of Exodus

Scripture:
Matthew 28:1-10

Group Gathering Question:

At dawn on Sunday, we read in Matthew 28 that the women went for a walk to look at Jesus' tomb. What does a typical Sunday morning look like for you?

Read this week's Scripture and discuss these questions.

1. When you consider the stories we've been studying in the book of Exodus (baby Moses in a basket, Moses committing murder, the burning bush, the Israelites as slaves in Egypt, wandering in the desert, manna, the 10 commandments, the golden calf, etc.) in what ways do you think they tie to this moment in scripture—the resurrection of Jesus?
2. How do you think Mary Magdalene and the other Mary felt on their way to the tomb? How does Matthew report they reacted when meeting and hearing from the angel?
3. The angel's report to the women can be broken down into four parts: 1) Do not be afraid; 2) He is not here; 3) Come and see; 4) Go quickly and tell. If you were there, which part of his report would you resonate with the most?
4. What is a fear in your life that you would like the resurrected savior to take from you?
5. How would you differentiate happiness from joy? How have you experienced joy in your life?
6. Jesus has been resurrected from death. What kind of theological truths does this tell us about who Jesus is, what he claimed, what he told the disciples about what would happen, and what we might hope for and believe at the end of our own lives and the lives of those we love?
