HOME GROUP QUESTIONS

Week 4 | 4.27.25
The Book of Exodus

Scripture:
Exodus 34:1-9

Group Gathering Question:

In looking back at Easter, do you find it more meaningful to focus on the sacrifice and suffering of Jesus on Good Friday or the hope of the resurrection on Easter Sunday?

Read this week's scripture and discuss these questions.

1. Why was it important to have a new set of stone tablets? In the days before computers, what was involved in replacing the first set?
2. Moses had asked to see God's glory in Exodus 33:18. In Exodus 34, God describes himself in showing his glory to Moses. How does God's description of himself in verses 6-7 fit the actions and the story in Exodus 32-33?
3. Trevor Hudson says, "There is a picture of God drawn inside each of our hearts and minds. This picture, formed over the years through various influences, significantly shapes the way we live our daily lives. As we reflect on our ideas about God, we are invited to enter a redrawing process in which we gain a clearer view of who God truly is." Think about your current image of God. What has influenced your picture of God throughout your lifetime (interactions with parents, church experience, culture, etc.)?
4. Take a look at Colossians 1:15. Jesus is described as the "image of the invisible God." How has your reading of the Gospels shaped your understanding of the character of God through the life of Jesus?
5. When you were a child, what consequences or punishment did you receive from your parents for misbehavior? Did your parents let you know they still loved you after punishment or consequences (see Exodus 34:6-9)?
6. Does it seem fair that the sins of the parents affect children, grandchildren and great-grandchildren? Discuss some ways we might see where children suffer for the sins of their parents even in modern-day life.
