Have you ever connected church membership with your spiritual growth under the care of elders/shepherds? Does this change the way you think about it? Why or why not? 	<p>Reflect</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Over the past two Sundays, we have discussed some fairly difficult subjects that churches often split over. What has this experience been like for you to discuss these things in Small Groups? How do you think God wants to grow us all through this experience? <p>Memorize 1 Corinthians 12:27 “Now you are the body of Christ and individually members of it.”</p>
