What is difficult about it? In what ways does this passage point us to Jesus? Why was this the moment God chose to “swear by Himself” to guarantee the Promise He made to Abraham? (vv.16-18) 	<p>Reflect</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Pastor Dave said that this passage points us to the fact that we can be certain of our salvation. Are you certain of your salvation? Why or why not? In what ways does the image of you being anchored to Jesus in heaven bring you comfort? Do you live as though you are really anchored to Jesus in this way?
