Do you believe he was a pre-incarnate appearance of Jesus or someone who is supposed to point us to Jesus? (a “type”) Why is Jesus said to have come from the “order of Melchizedek”? Why is this important? (See Psalm 110:4) 	<p>Reflect</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> We often say that we believe Jesus is greater than our circumstances, but often times, we still put our hope in other things other than Him. In what area of your life are you looking for peace right now? What are you tempted to put your hope in other than Him? How can this group help you trust Jesus through whatever it is you are going through? <p>Memorize Isaiah 9:6 (and 9:7 if able)</p>
