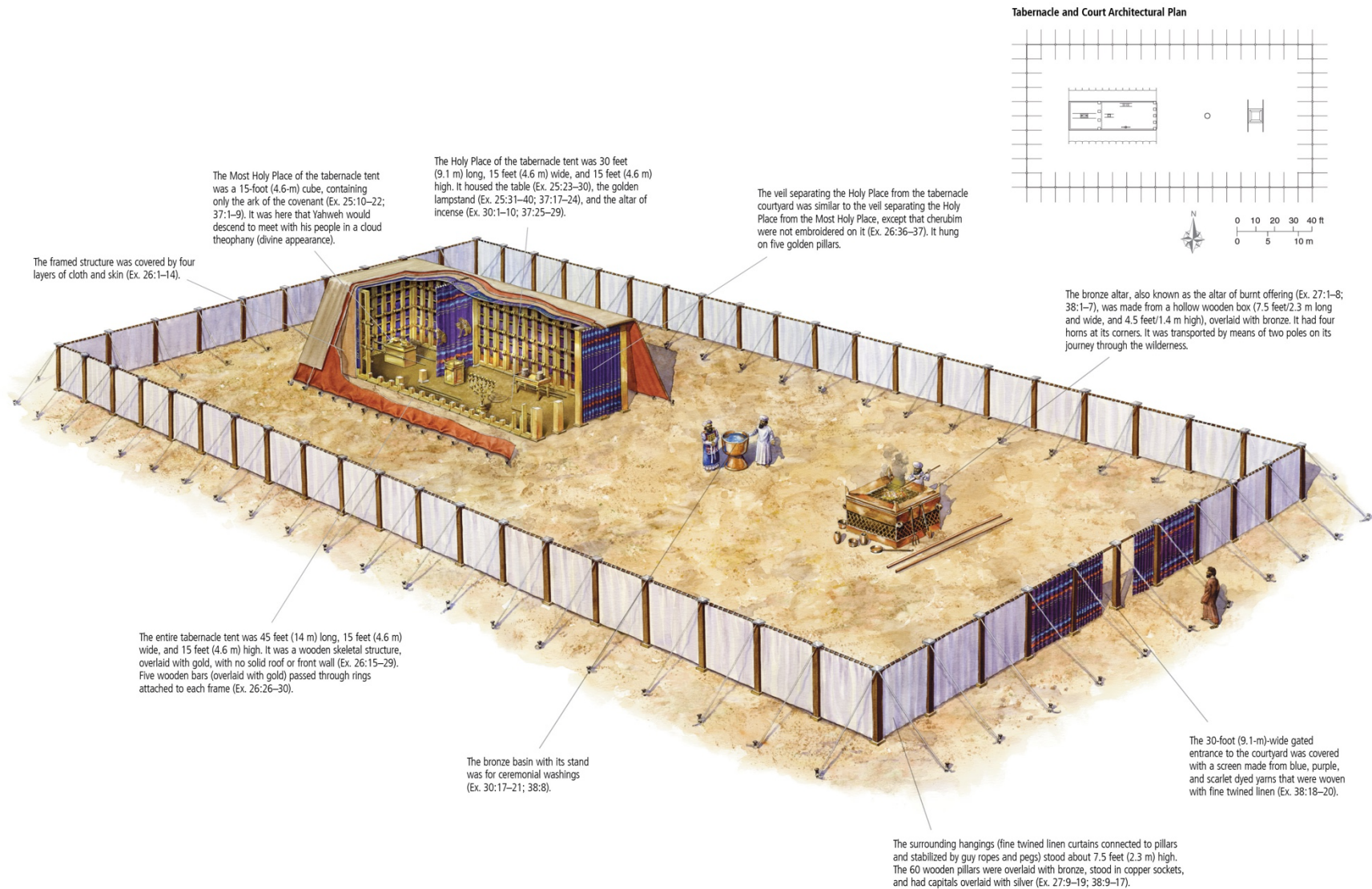

<p><b>Read</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Exodus 25:1-9</li> <li>And look over the headings and general ideas of Exodus 25-30.</li> </ul> <p><b>Discuss</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Has it ever been a struggle for you to read through passages like these in the Old Testament in the past? Why or why not?</li> <li>What new appreciation did this sermon give you for passages like these?</li> </ul>	<p><b>Diving Deeper Still</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Read Revelation 4-5</li> <li>Pastor Dave made some educated guesses about how the Throne Room in heaven is what the earthly Tabernacle was patterned after (based on the assertion in Heb 8:5; 9:11).</li> <li>What in your life feels out of order/control? What comfort does it bring you to know that God is the God of order and can bring order into your situation if you ask Him?</li> <li>What sin(s) are a persistent struggle for you? What comfort does it bring you to know that God has provided complete forgiveness for your sins in His Son, Jesus Christ?</li> </ul> <p><b>Memorize:</b> Hebrews 9:11-12</p>
