How does living in our sanitized world (where we buy pre-packaged meat from the grocery store, sit on cushioned seats in church, and take communion in pre-packaged cups) effect our connection to what is truly involved in sacrifice? What do you think God wants us to take away from reading a passage like this? 	<p>Reflection</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Pastor Dave made the statement: “One drop of Jesus’ blood is greater than all of the sin of humanity.” (Think about that.) Has there ever been a time in your life when you haven’t believed that Jesus could forgive <i>your</i> sin? If so, when? Why do we sometimes feel like we are the exception to His grace? How is God asking you to respond to His forgiveness today? <p>Memorize: Leviticus 17:11</p>
