That was an Old Testament requirement intended to support the priests and Levites (Lev 27:30). Instead, our <i>whole lives</i> are to be a sacrifice to God. Which of these is more difficult and why?

<p>Read</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Matthew 28:18-20 <p>Discuss</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Our “one priority” as followers of Jesus is to “make disciples”. This group is <i>one way</i> that happens. In what <i>other ways</i> have you discipled someone or been discipled and seen success? 	<p>Reflection</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> God is growing our church at an uncomfortable rate (at least for Pastor Dave who is writing this). If He is growing us, He is <i>trusting us</i> with those He is bringing. How can each of us in this group make sure there is always “more room at the table” for those He is bringing?
