<p><b>Read</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Hebrews 10:26-31</li> </ul> <p><b>Discuss</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Has this passage, or others like it, ever caused you to question your salvation? Why or why not?</li> <li>Now that we understand the context of this passage, what deliberate, continual sin is it addressing?</li> <li>It is important that we always run a passage of Scripture through the message of the gospel. Have two or three group members share the gospel. (Something we all need to be reminded of regularly).</li> </ul>	<p><b>Reflection</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>There are 3 types of people that this passage is written to:               <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li><b>The wanderer:</b> someone running from Jesus</li> <li><b>The weary:</b> a Christian who is tired from life’s difficulties</li> <li><b>The weak:</b> a Christian who is struggling with habitual sin</li> </ol> </li> <li>Would you describe yourself as one of these? Which one?</li> <li>To each Jesus gives a message:               <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>The wanderer: <b>come home</b></li> <li>The weary: <b>hold on</b></li> <li>The weak: <b>accept my love</b></li> </ol> </li> <li>Which one of these messages do you need to hear and why?</li> <li>Who is someone you know who fits into one of these categories that our group can be praying for?</li> </ul> <p><b>Memorize:</b> Matthew 5:11-12</p>
