<p>Review From Last Week</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Recite Hebrews 11:1 (and or 11:6) or any other Scriptures you are working on memorizing. <p>Getting to Know You</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> This chapter speaks about the things God Promises the believer that we can’t yet “see” (or experience). What are believers promised in Scripture that you are <i>most looking forward to</i> and why? 	<p>Read</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Philippians 3:12-21 <p>Discuss</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Where does Paul tell us his hope lies in this passage? What is the “goal” or the “prize” waiting for him? How does this impact the way he lives? (And the way he wants us to live?)

<p>Read</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Hebrews 11:17-22 <p>Discuss</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> This chapter assumes that its readers know the stories of Abraham, Isaac, Jacob, and Joseph. How familiar are you with these stories? Did you learn anything new this week? Why are all of these stories linked together? What do they have in common? What is the message we are supposed to take away from them? 	<p>Reflection</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> In the case of Isaac blessing Jacob and Esau, and Jacob blessing Ephraim and Manasseh, the one doing the blessing did what God led them to do, not what others expected. Has God ever asked you to do something that others didn’t expect? What did you do? How difficult was it to do? Is there something that God asking you to “press on” through in faith as you keep your eyes fixed on the “goal”? How might the way you handle this inspire others to live a life of faith? <p>Continue to Memorize: Hebrews 11:1 (Bonus: Hebrews 11:6)</p>
