<p><b>Read</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>● Luke 2:39-52</li> </ul> <p><b>Discuss</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>● Why do you think there is so little in scripture about Jesus’ childhood?</li> <li>● Why do you think Luke thought it important to include this account when the other Gospel writers did not?</li> </ul>	<p><b>Reflection</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>● How has your relationship with your parents evolved over the years?</li> <li>● How has your relationship with your children (if you have any) evolved over the years?</li> <li>● What can we learn about family from this passage?</li> <li>● What areas of your life do you struggle to find Jesus?</li> <li>● Is there a new area or way you think Jesus is calling you to search for him this year? (think spiritual disciplines: Bible reading plans, service, prayer, journaling etc.)</li> <li>● How is our group searching for Jesus together? How can we improve or be more intentional this year? (set specific goals)</li> </ul>
