<p>Read</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Luke 7:1-10 <p>Discuss</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Were you familiar with this passage before this week? • Like Pastor Dave, were there assumptions you made about the centurion? If so, what were they? • What stuck out to you about this story as we read it again this week? • What lesson did take away from it? 	<p>Application</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • The centurion was likely oblivious to what the two passages above say about God and Jesus, and yet he demonstrated faith as though he knew they were true. • We, on the other hand, know these passages very well, but often fail to live as though they are true. Why is that? • What is the greatest barrier in your life to trusting Jesus completely? (i.e. money; comfort; fear; bible knowledge) • What would it look like if this group began to live with faith like the centurion had? What would change in our lives? In our church?
