Take care (to believe)</li> <li>2. Exhort one another not to give into sin/disobedience</li> </ol> </li> <li>• How did it hit you that God didn’t allow Moses to enter the Promised Land because of his actions in Numbers 20:7-13?</li> <li>• How can this group challenge each other not to give into sin/disobedience in our own lives, so we don’t face loss of rest?</li> </ul> <p><b>Memorize</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Hebrews 3:15 “Today, if you hear his voice, do not harden your hearts as in the rebellion.”</li> </ul>
