<p>Read</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Galatians 3:15-20 <p>Discuss</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> When God ratified His covenant with Abraham, He ratified it alone, while Abraham slept. How does this factor in to Paul’s argument that ‘the Promise’ is greater than the Law that God gave Moses? Why would it be foolish to rely on the Law? Look up the word “aseity”. How does knowing this quality about God help us to trust in His Promises to us? Including the assurance of our salvation? 	<p>Applying God’s Word</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> To all groups: how do you interact with the OT Law? <ol style="list-style-type: none"> Avoid it? Try to follow it? Allow it to cause you to worship Jesus? To groups with women (including “Anyone Groups): do you believe that you are co-heirs of the Promise and of the same value and worth to God as men?
