

The Letters Of JOHN I II III

In addition to his Gospel and the Book of Revelation, John wrote three epistles that are included in the New Testament known simply as 1st John, 2nd John, and 3rd John. These short letters form a remarkable collection of writing filled with powerful imagery, engaging language, and immensely practical teachings.

Many people remember above all the injunction to love one another, flowing from God's own love that we experience in the person of Jesus. This kind of love is not an emotion but something expressed in practical action.

But if we think these letters are just about action, then we are misreading. They are actually concerned with a whole range of important theological issues. Central is the idea of knowing God, relationally and experientially, but also in a way which allows us to tell truth from falsehood.

Next to this is the truth about the person of Jesus, his death being an 'atoning sacrifice' which deals with our sins and leads to forgiveness and reconciliation with God. This shapes our understanding of our own lives as disciples.
