DISCUSSION GUIDE

THE CASE OF THE MISSING NUN

Psalm 145:13

1. The second part of Psalm 145:13 speaks to the faithfulness of the Lord. What are things that gnaw at our belief in God's faithfulness?
2. How can we as a community affirm our lived experiences but also the faithfulness of God?
3. The second part of Psalm 145:13 was missing for centuries from the latest Hebrew manuscripts, only to be found in the newly discovered earliest manuscripts. That it was ultimately found affirms, as the text says, God is faithful. How does the Lord's faithfulness to you inspire you to be faithful to your community?
4. When we think of God's faithfulness, do we see it as only for us, for me or do we really recognize His faithfulness toward all of creation? How might your answer change your view of God's faithfulness?
