Learn to Worship

### **Understanding God's Word in Worship**

1. Pastor Clint highlighted the importance of not just receiving God's Word but responding to it properly. Can you think of times when you've had biblical knowledge but failed to act on it?
2. During the sermon, Pastor Clint emphasized that we don't have to guess what God expects—He's told us in His Word. How does this truth bring you comfort? How does it challenge you?
3. What did you think about the Pastor's warning about those who claim the Lord told them something outside of Scripture? How do we balance this with being open to the Holy Spirit's leading?

### **The Role of Scripture in Our Lives**

1. The pastor mentioned how the Reformers freed the Bible from being "stuck in Latin" for a thousand years. How does having the Bible in your own language shape your relationship with God? Do we take this privilege for granted?
2. How your worship will show in how you live: This is the sermon's key theme. Can you share examples of how your understanding of worship has affected your daily choices?

### **Practical Application**

1. What does it mean for worship to be "dominated by the Word"? How can we ensure our personal and corporate worship stays centered on Scripture rather than our preferences or feelings?

2. The passage contains both commands to obey and prohibitions to avoid. Why do you think God gives us both? How do these boundaries actually lead to freedom in worship?

### **Personal Reflection**

1. Information vs. transformation: The sermon warns that information without action is useless. What's one truth from God's Word you know but haven't fully applied? What would it look like to act on that truth this week?
2. Examining our worship: If someone observed your life this past week, what would they conclude about who or what you worship? How does this align with what you say you believe?
