



## **Sermon Discussion Questions**

Exodus 25:31-40

The Lampstand: God is Good, and He Has Not Forgotten You

### **Created with Dignity**

1. Pastor Clint said the lampstand's intricate beauty reminds us we are "created with dignity." How does understanding yourself as God's "artwork" (Ephesians 2:10) change the way you see yourself?
2. In what ways does sin disfigure the image of God in us? How does the gospel restore our dignity?
3. Where do you see human dignity being attacked or diminished in our culture today? How should Christians respond?

### **You Are Not Alone**

1. The lampstand was made from one piece of gold but had many branches. How does this picture the church as the body of Christ?
2. Pastor Clint challenged the trend of watching church online instead of gathering in person. What do you think we miss when we're not physically present with other believers?

### **Called to Holiness**

1. What's the difference between "imputed righteousness" (what saves us) and "pursued righteousness" (how we live)? Why is it important to understand both?
2. The lampstand was made of "pure gold." What does holiness look like in everyday life—at work, at home, in your relationships?
3. How do we pursue holiness without falling into legalism or self-righteousness?

### **You Are Not in the Dark**

1. Jesus said we are "the light of the world" (Matthew 5:14-16). What does it mean practically to let your light shine in the places God has put you?
2. Where in your life do you feel like you're walking in darkness or uncertainty right now? How does the truth that "God is light" speak to that situation?

### **You Are Part of a Story**

1. Pastor Clint discussed God's full plan of redemption, spanning from creation to consummation. How does seeing your life as part of this larger story change your perspective?
2. The sermon's main message was: "God is good and has not forgotten you." When have you felt forgotten by God? How does the lampstand—with its constant light—offer encouragement in those moments?

### **Application Questions**

1. Which of these five points do you most need to hear right now? Why?
