What We Need In Order To Worship

1. In Exodus 19:12-13, God establishes strict boundaries around Mount Sinai, with severe consequences for those who cross them. How does this passage help us understand the importance of approaching God with reverence rather than casualness?
2. In what ways might you have become too casual in your approach to God, and what specific changes could you make to restore a proper reverence in your worship?
3. Pastor Clint explains that we need the Bible for worship because it reveals who God is, who we are, and how we are to live. What are some practical ways we can make Bible reading more central to our daily worship?
4. What obstacles prevent you from consistently reading God's Word, and how might you overcome them?
5. How does Moses' role as mediator between God and the Israelites point to Jesus as our ultimate mediator? Why do we need a mediator?
