



## **Sermon Discussion Questions**

Exodus 19:16-25

Meeting God on the Mountain

1. Pastor Clint described God's appearance on Mount Sinai, accompanied by thunder, lightning, thick clouds, and the sound of trumpet blasts. Why do you think God chose to reveal Himself in such a dramatic and frightening way, and what does this tell us about His character?
2. When was the last time you felt truly in awe of God's power and majesty, and how did it affect your worship?
3. Pastor Clint emphasized that there is an 'uncrossable chasm' between humans and God due to our sinfulness, and that even looking upon God's holiness would result in death. How does understanding the vast difference between God's holiness and our sinfulness impact your appreciation of Jesus's role as mediator?
4. According to the sermon, what's the difference between saying 'nobody's perfect' and having true conviction of sin? Why is this distinction important?
5. How does the contrast between Mount Sinai (in Exodus) and Mount Zion (in Hebrews 12) help us understand the difference between the law and grace?
6. Pastor Clint mentioned several appropriate responses to understanding God's holiness, including awe, reverence, daily repentance, worship, and singing. Which of these responses do you think modern Christians struggle with most, and why?
7. What practical steps could you take to cultivate a more profound sense of reverence in your own worship life?
