Old Testament Stories (God & His People)

- **Creation** – *Genesis 1:1–5, 26–31*

- **God Rests** – *Genesis 2:1–3*
God values rest and blessing.
- **Noah Trusts God** – *Genesis 6:13–22*
Obedience even when it's hard or confusing.
- **God's Promise to Abraham** – *Genesis 12:1–4*
God calls people to trust and go.
- **Joseph Forgives** – *Genesis 50:15–21*
Forgiveness and God's bigger plan.
- **God Hears His People** – *Exodus 3:7–12*
God sees, hears, and sends help.
- **Crossing the Red Sea** – *Exodus 14:10–14, 21–31*
God makes a way when there seems to be none.
- **The Ten Commandments (Heart Focus)** – *Exodus 20:1–17*
God gives rules because He loves His people.
- **David and Goliath** – *1 Samuel 17:32–37, 45–50*
God is bigger than our fears.
- **The Lord Is My Shepherd** – *Psalms 23*
God cares, leads, and protects.

- **Jesus Calls the First Disciples** – *Luke 5:1–11*
Following Jesus means trusting Him.
- **Jesus Calms the Storm** – *Mark 4:35–41*
Jesus has power, even when we are afraid.
- **Jesus Heals a Paralytic** – *Mark 2:1–12*
Jesus forgives and heals.
- **Jesus Welcomes Children** – *Mark 10:13–16*
Jesus loves and values kids.
- **The Good Samaritan** – *Luke 10:30–37*
Loving others means action.
- **The Lost Sheep** – *Luke 15:3–7*
God cares deeply for every person.
- **Zacchaeus** – *Luke 19:1–10*
Jesus changes hearts and lives.
