

Things to know...

- Tuition credits will not be given due to absences, holidays, early release, bad weather days, or school closures
- We will start the first Tuesday after Labor Day weekend
- The School at Parkhills closely follows the NEISD calendar for holidays and bad weather days
- Absences, holidays, early release, bad weather days, and school closure days will not be made up
- Children will not be accepted before 8:45am
- Pick up time begins at 1:50pm. A late fee of \$5 will be assessed for pickup after 2:10pm and is automatically applied
- Children will not be released to unauthorized people
- All children must bring a lunch
- Label all items brought to school
- Children must bring a blanket or mat for rest time (age applicable)
- Dress appropriately for school play
- Inform director of any allergies or special needs at the time of registration
- Any child who has had fever, diarrhea, or a contagious illness or disease within 24 hours of a school day, or who has had exposure to anyone with a communicable disease may not be left at our program
- If your child becomes ill during the day, you will be notified immediately
- Medication will not be administered to any child during our program

The School at Parkhills GUIDELINES

- Families with multiple children enrolled at The School at Parkhills will receive a \$30 discount off monthly tuition for each additional child.
- A late fee of \$30 will be assessed to outstanding accounts after the 10th of the month.
- A 4% discount will be given when the 23-24 tuition payment is paid in full by September 10, 2024.

▶ Whether learning how to crawl or walk in line, learning colors, shapes, numbers and letters, how to read and write, or whether they are studying the scientific method, they are acquiring knowledge and skills to advance them to the next level in the learning process.

Our 3 year old and Pre-Kindergarten classes incorporate a variety of curricula. This curricula includes materials for handwriting, pre-reading and reading skills, and math concepts, and is a Kindergarten ready program, following TEKS for Pre-K. The curricula is used in conjunction with units of study such as seasons, space, math, science, reading, social studies, and much more.

Our Gift of Time class introduces and practices Kindergarten TEKS. This class grants extra time for students to mature academically and socially preparing them for future success.

Our grade school provides homeschooled students with supplemental learning and socialization in a one-room schoolhouse classroom setting. They use a variety of curricula and practice grade level TEKS.
