






SUMMER CREATION CARE TIPS



There are some empowering ways to stay cool without using air conditioning, or at least using less A/C. Besides being good for the environment, like many climate friendly tips, it also saves money. One way to stay cool in summer besides just air conditioning is to use a fan. A ceiling fan should spin counter clockwise in summer to push cool air down. Using a mister or placing ice in front of a fan can increase the cooling effect. Be sure to turn fans off when no one is in the room to save energy, as it is only helpful when the air is moving past skin. Blocking the sun into a home with shades pulled during the hottest part of day, using awnings and planting trees to shade can be helpful. Opening windows at night to create a cross breeze is refreshing. Make sure to close windows in the morning to prevent warmth from seeping in. Avoid using your oven/stove, clothes dryer, dishwasher and unnecessary lights during the heat of the day to keep indoors cooler. A dehumidifier can also make your house feel cooler. Recommendations to keep your body cooler include taking a cool shower, with hair drying naturally, staying hydrated and applying cool towels with ice to neck, wrists, feet and other pulse points. Wear loose fitting, light colored clothing and think about cooling sheets for your bed. Air conditioning is a wonderful comfort, however, can you get by with the setting a few degrees higher with these techniques? Have a fabulous summer!
