



CREATION CARE TEAM UPDATE

Bethel Lutheran Church has been converting a lot of fixtures and lights from fluorescent to LED. There are many reasons to convert from fluorescent to LED including:

- Energy efficiency-LED lights are 80% more efficient than fluorescents, which can save 20-50% or more on energy costs.
- Lifespan-LEDs can last 10 times longer than fluorescent lights.
- Environmentally friendly- LED lights do not contain mercury, and do not require as many replacements.
- Safety-LED lights are shatterproof and sturdier than fluorescent lights.

With the replacements of the bulbs, there were about 300 fluorescent bulbs waiting for proper disposal here at Bethel. The mercury and other metals they contain could be harmful to environment and human health if not recycled by a licensed hazardous waste handler.

Bethel Creation Care team was pleased to find a licensed recycling company, box up and deliver the bulbs and pay the fee required for proper disposal!
