

Confirmation Overview

Welcome to the preparation process for the sacrament of Confirmation. We are so excited to be walking alongside you as you prepare to receive what is such an amazing sacrament. Please make sure to bring a notepad and pen to your sessions as well as an open heart. If you have any questions, do reach out to Andy Watts at awatts@guardian-angels.org or 651-789-3173.

Confirmation requirements

We are excited to help our young people who are in ninth grade and up in preparing to receive the sacrament of Confirmation. Young people preparing must complete the following steps:

- Attend eight monthly sessions. Please see dates on the Confirmation schedule.
- Attend weekly Mass. (4:30pm Vigil, 8:30am or 11am)
- Paperwork – Sponsor Form, Candidate Form, provide Baptism Certificate (if not baptized at Guardian Angels, contact the church of baptism to receive an official copy).
- Attend Confirmation Retreat (Jan/Feb 2027)

The Confirmation ceremony will be celebrated at the Cathedral in St. Paul in spring of 2027, Date TBD.

Steps to complete your preparation:

1. **Register** with Andy Watts, details above. Request all forms needed upon contact.
2. **Complete Waiver/Release Form** at https://s3.amazonaws.com/account-media/16450/uploaded/w/0e10984456_1691443280_waiversignatureforms-minors.pdf
3. **Attend all eight monthly sessions**, find dates on the schedule.
4. **Choose a Sponsor and Submit the Sponsor Form.** We ask that you choose a practicing Confirmed Catholic. A godparent from baptism is a great option. Someone who can attend all eight sessions with you. This person can support you in faith throughout the process and be of great influence throughout your life.
5. **Choose your Confirmation name**, this may be the confirmand's baptismal name or another Christian name, such as a saint, blessed, or someone from the Old

Testament. It can be someone who has already been influential or someone you find interest in learning more about.

6. **Paperwork – Sponsor Form, Candidate Form, provide Baptism Certificate**

(updated Certificate or Baptism if not baptized at Guardian Angels)

Read carefully - If your child was not baptized at Guardian Angels Catholic Church, you must contact the church where he/she was baptized and have them send Guardian Angels an official copy of their baptismal certificate.

7. **Attend weekly Mass**, 4:30pm Saturday Vigil, 8:30am or 11am on Sundays

8. **Attend Confirmation Rite of Sending Mass** (Date TBC)
