ADMINISTRATOR'S UPDATE

- The Engagement Commission firmed up plans for the 2024 Stewardship Campaign that kicks off on October 7-8 and will run for three weekends. The first weekend will be the financial ask and the next two weekends will promote Time and Talent. Zach Stachowski and terry Quinn will speak on Loving God and Generosity. They continue to discuss on how they can encourage staff, commissions, committees and clubs to nominate new volunteers for the new St. Michael Rising Star Award. We now have three nominees and are looking for more.
 The next New Parishioner Brunch is scheduled for Sunday, November 12 after the 11:00 Mass. In an effort to focus on reaching out, the Engagement Commission has also suggested an event for newly-baptized children and newly-weds.
- Church Doors: Repairs to the lower entrance (Door 6), including new doors, have been completed. Insurance covered all but our \$1,000 deductible.

 The door replacement project (Doors 1,10, and 11) has been delayed to October because the company switched manufacturers. As shared earlier, these new doors will be locked during business hours during the week and visitors will be "buzzed" in for safety and security purposes.
- Fall Festival: Big Tickets are substantially behind the average for the last three years. We thank Kendre Turonie and Viky Turner for agreeing to be parishioner Co-chairs of this year's festival and working with Sharon Schwarz, GA staff liaison to manage the two-day event. Ticket Sales, which account for 80% of proceeds, are at \$70,000. The goal is \$100,000. GA set out 780 ticket packets of which about 50% were picked up. The packets were made based on who sold tickets over the last three years. Other big draw is the Silent Auction, this year there are 900 items on sale.
- Save the date: October 1 for the first annual Fried Chicken Dinner to celebrate the feast of Guardian Angels from 12-4 pm.
