Key Verse: John 6:8–11

⁸ Another of his disciples, Andrew, Simon Peter's brother, spoke up, ⁹ "Here is a boy with five small barley loaves and two small fish, but how far will they go among so many?"

¹⁰ Jesus said, "Have the people sit down." There was plenty of grass in that place, and they sat down (about five thousand men were there). ¹¹ Jesus then took the loaves, gave thanks, and distributed to those who were seated as much as they wanted. He did the same with the fish.

Key Questions

1. All it took Jesus to do a miracle was for someone to give Jesus all they had left to give (the boy gave Jesus the rest of his food), what could you give Jesus that you're currently in control of? What are your "five pieces of bread and two pieces of fish?" Do you have the faith that he can do the impossible with what you have left?

2. In Matthew's telling of the story, Jesus purposefully used the disciples to hand out the food to the 20,000+ in attendance that day, how can you allow Jesus to use you to work miracles in other people's lives?
