Use this discussion guide with your small group or by yourself, to dig into the text and theme of Sunday's message.

Key Point: Time is a gift from God that we are invited to use for His glory.

Life Sharing: (answer one)

- 1. What does it take for you to have a great day? What are 1 or 2 things that need to happen?
- 2. Tell us about your best day last month. What made it the best?

3. What is the biggest "time-stealer" in your life?

Life Examination:

READ John 7:1-13

- 4. What did Jesus family, the crowd and the religious leaders think about Jesus?
- 5. What is the Festival of Tabernacles about and how did the people celebrate it?
- 6. What was the "time" Jesus referenced in these verses?
- 7. Why do you think Jesus went up to Jerusalem after saying he wasn't going to go?

READ Isaiah 58:1-10

- 8. Why is the faith expression of the people of God problematic?
- 9. What kind of fasting honors God?
- 10. How does God want the people to use their time?

Life Application:

- 11. How would you feel and what would you do if you found out that someone hated you?
- 12. What are some reasons that people hesitate to talk about spiritual things in our current culture? What can you do to create spiritual conversations even with those challenges?
- 13. Have you ever fasted and prayed in a more desperate way? What happened?
- 14. Isaiah 58:6 talks about chains and yokes. What are the chains and yokes in operation today that keep people from freedom?

Life Prayers: Pray for one another and ask God to help each person use their time in a way that honors Him.
