

Sermon Discussion Guide

November 10th, 2024 Use this discussion guide with your small group or by yourself, to dig into the text and theme of Sunday's message.

Key Point: Jesus can satisfy our spiritual thirst.

Life Sharing: (answer one)

When you are thirsty what is your favorite thing to drink?
Describe a time when you were desperate for water.

Transition / Open in prayer

3. When has an important friendship in your life changed and you felt the relationship become something different?

Life Examination: *READ John 7:33-44* 4. Where was Jesus going? (verses 33-34) 5. What is the living water Jesus was offering? How does this symbol of water connect to the Feast of Tabernacles?6. When did Jesus' followers receive the Spirit? Why is the Spirit given to those who follow Jesus?7. Who is the Prophet (verse 40) and the Messiah (verse 41) that the people were waiting for?

READ Isaiah 55:1-8

8. Why do you think Isaiah uses the images of wine, milk, and bread to describe what God is offering the people?9. What does verse 6 mean? When is God not near to His people?

10. Why does God want His people to understand that His ways are not their ways?

Life Application:

11. What does a spiritually thirst person look like?

12. Describe a time when you felt the Spirit of God giving you hope, strength, or wisdom for a life situation you were facing.

13. What can separate a person from the gifts of the Spirit?14. What are some ways you can create a hunger for God in other people's lives?

Life Prayers: Pray for one another and ask God to keep each of you thirsty for more of His power and presence.
