Key Point: Jesus was sent to help us fight sin.

Life Sharing: (answer one)

- 1. What are some things or behaviors that most people would call evil?
- 2. What are some things or behaviors that most people would call good?

Transition / Open in prayer

3. What are some things that make believing in Jesus difficult?

Life Examination:

READ John 8:42-51

- 4. How would you answer the question Jesus asks in verse
- 43, why can't the people understand what Jesus is saying?
- 5. Why does Jesus say they belong to the devil?
- 6. What is the evidence that someone belongs to God?
- 7. Why is death avoided by obeying Jesus' teaching?

READ 1 John 3:7-11

- 8. What is the work of the devil? (vs. 8)
- 9. What does John mean when he says, "go on sinning" (vs. 9)
- absolutely, habitually, deliberately, etc.?
- 10. How can we understand what John says in verse 10 when we compare it with 1 John 1:8?

Life Application:

- 11. What are the places or seasons where you feel closest to God?
- 12. What are some factors in life that might cause someone to feel distant from God?
- 13. What are the ways we can stand against the work of the devil? How can we stand together?
- 14. What are some things a person can do to face temptation without sin? If you had a friend who struggled with a certain temptation, what would you encourage them to do?

Life Prayers: Pray for one another and for our common struggle with sin.
