Use this discussion guide with your small group or by yourself, to dig into the text and theme of Sunday's message.

Key Point: Jesus gave his life for us. Life Sharing: (answer one)

- 1. What is your favorite part of Easter?
- 2. If you had 15 seconds to tell someone what Easter is all about what would you say?

Transition / Open in prayer

3. What do you do when you get bad news? Who do you tell first?

Life Examination:

READ John 20:1-18

4. How does Jesus' resurrection story compare to the resurrection of Lazareth? (John 11:38-44)

- 5. What are the different ways the followers of Jesus responded to the empty tomb?
- 6. Why does John pay attention to the condition of the grave clothes?
- 7. Why do you think Mary did not recognize Jesus immediately?

READ 1 Peter 2:21-25

- 8. What does it mean to follow Jesus' example of suffering? What kind of suffering do people experience in life?
- 9. Why did Jesus die, according to this passage?
- 10. What makes Jesus a good spiritual Shepherd?

Life Application:

- 11. When compared, the gospel resurrection stories have different details and some disagreements (for example: how many angels were at the tomb, was Mary alone or with others, what time of the morning was it, etc.) What are some ways to understand these differences?
- 12. Put yourself in Mary, Peter, and John's place. How do you think you would respond to the empty tomb?
- 13. What does Jesus' resurrection mean to the world? What does it mean to you?
- 14. What kind of "death" are you experiencing recently? What are some ways Jesus can bring new life to those things?
- 15. If you could ask God to give you guidance today, what kind of guidance would you ask for?

Life Prayers: Pray for one another and thank God for sending Jesus to die and rise again, that we might live.
