READ Psalm 103:8-13

8. Why doesn't God treat us as we deserve to be treated?
9. Which word picture for forgiveness do you like best?
10. Define the word "fear" in verse 13.

11. How would you answer Jesus' question to Peter, if He asked you the same question?
12. We all fail. We all fall short of God's perfect love. What are some ways a person should process their spiritual failures so that their faith can be renewed?
13. What are some ways that we compare our lives to others? Why is this so dangerous?
