

Sermon Discussion Guide

September 14, 2025

Use this discussion guide with your small group or by yourself, to dig into the text and theme of Sunday's message.

Key Point: Sharing our faith requires faith to share.

Life Sharing: (answer one)

- 1. Do you have a "green thumb" or do plants die around you? If you have a "green thumb", what makes you a good grower? If you don't, why do plants die around you?
- 2. Have you ever been responsible for your home's lawn? What does it take to have a healthy lawn around a house?

Transition / Open in prayer

3. What has helped your faith grow? Is there a certain time of your life when there was significant spiritual growth?

Life Examination:

READ Mark 4:3-20

- 4. What do the different parts of Jesus' story represent: the farmer, seeds, soils, birds, rocks, hot sun, thorns, and the crop?
- 5. What does verse 12 mean? Read Isaiah 6:9-10 and discuss.
- 6. What is the fruit Jesus talks about in verse 19?

READ Mark 4:21-25

- 7. How do these verses connect to the story about the soil?
- 8. What do the words "something" and "nothing" refer to in verse 25?

Life Application:

- 9. What are some things a person can do to make sure their heart is like the good soil?
- 10. Why do trouble and worry cause followers of Jesus to struggle to produce good fruit?
- 11. Verse 24 says when you give, you will receive more. What is Jesus expecting us to give?
- 12. How can the four soil imagery help us in sharing our faith with others?

Life Prayers: Pray for one another and ask that God would expand your faith so that others could see Him.
