# Key Point: All people are made in the image of God and have value.

### Life Sharing: (answer one)

- 1. If you haven't reviewed the Small Group Covenant / Agreement, take time to do that before starting the discussion.
- 2. If you had to visit a health profession tomorrow, which one would you want to see: doctor, dentist, chiropractor, or therapist.

3. What are some ways people have labeled you in your life? Have those labels been good or bad for your understanding of yourself?

#### Life Examination:

READ Matthew 9:1-13

- 4. How are the paralyzed man and Matthew, a tax collector, similar according to Jewish culture? What are some of the labels in Jewish culture that show up in these stories?
- 5. How would you answer Jesus' question in verse 5?
- 6. Why do you think Matthew responded to Jesus' invitation to follow him? What did Jesus' invitation mean to Matthew?
- 7. What are the types of people Jesus talks about in verses 12-13? Who are the people in Jesus' day that fit under those labels?

READ 1 John 1:5-10

- 8. What does light symbolize in this passage?
- 9. Why is confessing our sins important?

#### **Life Application:**

- 10. Who helped you respond to Jesus' invitation to follow him?
- 11. What is needed for someone to realize they are spiritually sick?
- 12. What can we learn from Jesus' example as we reach out to all people?
- 13. How can a person tell if they are walking in light or walking in darkness?

**Life Prayers:** Pray for one another and ask God to move your heart toward those who are spiritually sick.
