Use this discussion guide with your small group or by yourself, to dig into the text and theme of Sunday's message.

Key Point: Kindness is a Godly character trait.

Life Sharing: (answer one)

- 1. Have you or anyone else in your family farmed land? What does it take to cultivate farmland?
- 2. Was there ever a time when someone stood up for you? Tell the story about that moment in your life.

Transition / Open in prayer

3. Al Capone is attributed with the quote, "Don't mistake my kindness for weakness." Why would kindness be associated with weakness?

Life Examination:

READ Ruth 2:1-9

- 4. What do we learn about Boaz in this passage? What do we learn about Ruth?
- 5. Why did Naomi and Ruth think she could go glean in someone else's field? *Look up Leviticus 23:22 and Deuteronomy 24:19-22 for more context.*
- 6. How does Boaz provide for Ruth, and for Naomi through Ruth?

READ Ruth 2:10-23

- 7. How does Boaz continue to show kindness to Ruth?
- 8. How would you sum up Ruth's response and behavior?
- 9. What impact does Ruth's day and interaction with Boaz have on Naomi?

READ Luke 7:11-17

10. How is this passage like the themes in the Book of Ruth?11. In what ways are Boaz and Jesus similar? How are they different?

Life Application:

- 12. Define kindness. What are a few ways people experience kindness in our world today?
- 13. Describe a time in your life when things came together in a way that some might label "coincidence" but you believe God was working behind the scenes.
- 14. What character traits of Ruth or Boaz do you want to develop in your life? What are some ways to do that?

Life Prayers: Pray for one another and ask God to grow your faith that He is always working and redeeming our lives.
