

# **Sermon Discussion Guide**

Use this discussion guide with your small group or by yourself, to dig into the text and theme of Sunday's message.

# Key Point: Jesus redeems and shows us God's favor.

## Life Sharing: (answer one)

- 1. What is something you are thankful for today?
- 2. When you were growing up, how did you make a promise to a friend or sibling? (i.e. pinky promise, blood brother, etc.)

#### **Transition / Open in prayer**

3. Tell the group about a time you needed someone to help you, but they could not help or resolve the issue.

#### **Life Examination:**

READ Ruth 4:1-12

- 4. How would you describe what is happening in this passage? If you were a reporter, what are two questions you would ask the eyewitnesses of this gathering?
- 5. Why do you think the first kinsman-redeemer doesn't redeem Ruth or the land?
- 6. Why did Boaz need 10 elders, a sandal, and all the other people to be witness to what was happening?
- 7. Why is the blessing of the people (verse 12) surprising as it relates to Ruth's history?

#### READ Luke 4:14-21

- 8. The "year of the Lord's favor" is connected to the year of Jubilee from Leviticus 25:8-13. How is the Jubilee year connected to Ruth's story?
- 9. What is the purpose of the year of the Lord's favor?
- 10. What are some ways Jesus accomplished this purpose?

### **Life Application:**

- 11. What character traits that Boaz and Ruth embody are traits you would like to see in your life?
- 12. How does making our decisions and commitments public deepen and strengthen them?
- 13. It was surprising that Boaz decided to redeem Ruth. What is surprising about who Jesus' chose to redeem?
- 14. What are some ways you experience the favor of God in your everyday life?
- 15. Describe a time in your life when you needed God to redeem you from poverty, captivity, blindness, or oppression. If you have a hard time remembering a time, think about it from a spiritual perspective.

**Life Prayers:** Pray for one another and ask God to redeem each one in your group.
