Life Examination:

READ Matthew 14:22-36

4. Why did Jesus send the disciples ahead without him? What does this tell us about Jesus?
5. What does this story tell us about Peter and his relationship with Jesus?
6. Why did Peter sink in the water?
7. What does verse 35-36 tell us about the faith of the people?

READ Psalm 139:13-17

8. Why do you think David used the words "fearfully and wonderfully" to describe how God puts us together?
9. How does this song speak to our self-image and value?

Life Application:

10. When have you felt moved or called by God to do something risky? How did you respond?
11. What are some things that can cause us to take our eyes of Jesus?
12. How does personality impact our faith and our discipleship in the way of Jesus?
13. What one question would you want to ask God, since He put you together on purpose and knows all your days?
14. What are the ways you describe your personality to others?
