

A Message from the Pastor

Acts 1:8... But you will receive power when the Holy Spirit has come upon you, and you will be my witnesses in Jerusalem and in all Judea and Samaria, and to the end of the earth.

In November of 2006 seven members of FBC Seabrook traveled to Senegal to share the gospel. That trip was our first as an "Acts 1:8" church. I believe that Acts 1:8 is the outline of mission work for all churches; Jerusalem, Judea, Samaria and to the end of the earth. The church of Jesus Christ is uniquely empowered for this work.

Tomorrow morning Wayne Stewart and I leave for another trip to Senegal. There are opportunities for everyone to be part of the Great Commission!





