Under the prayed-for guidance of the Holy Spirit, Ashley and her stellar band of volunteers presented a nearly flawless week of gospel fun to 120 or so well-fed kids and their families! I wrote "most teachers and volunteers" because this morning (6/21/24) a team of eleven missionaries left our church for Puerto Rico. Nearly all the team were part of our VBS. In fact, our VBS served as training for the VBS they will be presenting in Puerto Rico! Pray for these brothers in sisters in Christ as they share the gospel (in Spanish!) to the residents of Vieques, Puerto Rico!

The mission focus during VBS was Bethlehem Land in Senegal. We have made a 3-year commitment to focus on realizing the vision of a self-sustained agricultural ministry with a worship center, school and clinic. Please continue to pray as Bethlehem Land navigates the challenges of a Christian ministry in an impoverished Muslim majority nation!
