What is the purpose of the church?

Acts 2:42... And they devoted themselves to the apostles' teaching and the fellowship, to the breaking of bread and the prayers.

Here we see four of the purposes of the church (there are more than four) – Teaching of doctrine, Fellowship, Breaking of bread and prayer.

We accomplish the first purpose, teaching of doctrine, through the ministry of the Word in our worship services, through the various group ministries (Men's Ministry and Women's Ministry...) and through our Sunday School program. 



Due to limited space there is a need to reserve your spot. Follow Hap's on Facebook and you should be able to make your reservation there or call 281-525-6167.


