

A Worship Discussion Guide for Individuals, Groups & Families for the week of October 26, 2025

Read the Bible passage aloud in your group meeting. This is a worship discussion guide, and our reflections and applications are grounded in Scripture. You do not need to work through the whole guide. Decide which points would be most helpful for your meeting, and use them as a starting point for your time together.

John 14:1-7 In My Father's House are Many Rooms

- ¹"Let not your hearts be troubled. Believe in God; believe also in me. ² In my Father's house are many rooms. If it were not so, would I have told you that I go to prepare a place for you? ³ And if I go and prepare a place for you, I will come again and will take you to myself, that where I am you may be also. ⁴ And you know the way to where I am going." ⁵ Thomas said to him, "Lord, we do not know where you are going. How can we know the way?" ⁶ Jesus said to him, "I am the way, and the truth, and the life. No one comes to the Father except through me. ⁷ If you had known me, you would have known my Father also. From now on you do know him and have seen him."
- How are you affected when you are troubled?
- Why does Jesus command the disciples "believe in God" and then "believe also in me"? (1)
- What is the connection between a troubled heart and belief?
- How does Jesus describe His Father's house? What is Jesus communicating about His Father? (2)
- Jesus shares that when he comes again, He will take us to Himself. What is it like to consider that our destination is Jesus Himself? How might this change your view of eternal life? (3)
- What question does Thomas ask, and what does this reveal about his heart? (5)

- What does it mean for Jesus to be the Way, Truth, and Life? (6)
- What is the relationship between knowing Jesus and knowing the Father? (6-7)
- How do you need Jesus to calm your troubled heart?
- Pray together in light of this week's passage.
